Re: Notice of Drainage Improvements

We are writing to let you know that Sturgeon County is planning drainage upgrades in your area this summer. A contractor hired by Sturgeon County will be making improvements to the ditches to enhance drainage and reduce flood risks.

Scope of work

Ditch grade improvements will be made, and culverts will be replaced along Sturgeon Crescent. This work will address historical flooding concerns, and we expect the project will take one to two months to complete. Please be aware that construction schedules may change depending on weather conditions.

What this means to you

There will be Sturgeon County project personnel, contractor crews, and equipment working in the area. Intermittent one lane and full road closures may take place. Detour information will be provided before any closure takes place. Access to business will be maintained at all times.
