Dear Property Owners and Residents:

Subject: Notice of County Bridge Culvert Replacement (BF 00646)

We are writing to let you know that Sturgeon County is planning significant infrastructure improvements in your area this year. The bridge culvert on Range Road 262, north of Township Road 565 that spans a tributary stream to Little Egg Creek, has been in service since 1910. It is in poor condition and is now nearing the end of its serviceable life. To ensure the safety of those using the bridge, the County will be replacing the structure in the 2024 construction season.

Scope of work

The project involves removing the current bridge culvert, improvements to the road, and installing a new structure. We will have a better idea of when this work will be done once the design is finalized and a contractor is chosen; however, it is anticipated that the project will be done between July and November 2024. Please be aware that construction schedules may change depending on weather conditions.

What this means to you

There will be Sturgeon County project personnel and contractor crews working within and around the project area. A temporary road closure will be required, and signage will be in place to direct traffic around the detour.
