Dear Resident/Landowner,

Re: Gravel Road Improvement - Range Road 230A - Township Road 570 to Railway Crossing

This summer, a Sturgeon County contractor will be improving the gravel roads in your area. This work may involve shoulder pulling, subgrade compaction, clay fills in specialized areas, re-graveling as well as culvert replacements/drainage improvements, and tree removal/brushing as needed in each location.

What this means to you

You may see survey crews on-site to identify workspaces in advance of construction. Once surveying is done, the contractor will move their equipment to the worksite shortly before the work starts, and they will be in the area for about 10-15 days. The workdays are weather dependent and are subject to change.

Residents may experience brief traffic disruptions or delays along with temporary road closures. Notification will be provided 48 hours in advance for any temporary full road closures.
