Dear Property Owners and Residents:

Re: Notice of Road Construction on Township Road 564

We are writing to let you know that Sturgeon County is planning significant infrastructure improvements in your area this summer. A contractor hired by Sturgeon County will be working on Township Road 564. The project will upgrade the existing road to meet the County's general municipal servicing standards for rural highways, enhancing safety, ride quality, and drainage.

Scope of work

This project will rehabilitate Township Road 564 from east of Highway 28 to east of Range Road 231, and on the west side of Highway 28 to the Goose Hummock Golf Course entrance. A total of 2.2 km of roadway will be reconstructed and paved with asphalt.

A bridge culvert (BF 00889) located about 900 metres east of Highway 28 on Township Road 564 will be replaced. We expect the project, including the bridge work, will take about four months to complete. Please be aware that construction schedules may change depending on weather conditions.

What this means to you

There will be Sturgeon County project personnel, contractor crews, and equipment working in the area. Construction will take place Monday to Saturday between the hours of 7 a.m. - 5 p.m. The road will be open for alternate lane traffic during construction, except when the bridge structure is replaced. During that work, the road immediately before and after the bridge will be fully closed for about four weeks. Road detour information will be provided before the work begins.
