Dear Resident/Landowner,

Re: Drainage Improvement - Cardiff Pittsburgh

We are writing to let you know that starting this May, a Sturgeon County contractor will be working on drainage improvements in your area. This work includes roadside ditching and culvert replacements.

You may see survey crews on-site before construction begins. Once the surveying is done, the contractor will move their equipment to the worksite shortly before the work starts, and they will be in the area for about 10-15 days. Please be aware that the construction schedule may change depending on weather conditions.

## What this means to you

Residents will experience temporary road closures and brief delays when traffic is reduced to a single lane. Notification will be provided 48 hours in advance for any temporary full road closures, and signage will be in place along the road.
